## Hunting Rates BUFFALO HILL 2019

Per Day: \$ 600,-

### Including following Services:

- Lodging, including all meals (no alcohol)
- Experienced Hunting Guide
- ATV or Horse
- Trophy Preparation (Skinning, Salting or Bleaching)

Day of arrival and departure: \$ 300,-

### Shooting Fees:

- Canadian Moose (8 hunting days, 1:1 guidance) \$ 6.000,-
- Black Bear (8 hunting days, 1:1 guidance) \$ 2.000,-
- Mule Deer (8 hunting days, 1:1 guidance) \$ 2.000,-
- Wolf (except for the license fee) **Free**
- Fishing (except for the license fee) **Free**

We recommend 12 Hunting Days for Combination Hunts!

### One time Guide Fee at location:

- Skinning of Bear or Wolf CAD 250,-
- Moose (from 40" on) CAD 100,-
- Moose (from 50" on) CAD 200,-
- Moose (from 60" on) CAD 300,-

(5% GST on all Shooting Fees)

### One Time additional Costs:

- Transportation from & to Edmonton Airport to Camp \$ 1.000,-
- Organization Costs per Hunter or Companion \$ 150,-

Companions are very Welcome for half of the Living Expenses.

### Licenses and Government Fees:

- Non Resident Hunting Preservation Fund: CAD 200,-
- Canadian Hunting License: CAD 180,-
- Canadian Weapon Import License: CAD 25,-
- Moose: CAD 250,-
- Mountain Caribou: CAD 230,-
- Mule Deer: CAD 125,-
- Black Bear: CAD 180,-
- Wolf: CAD 50,-
